ENTRANCE ANTIPHON

FIRST READING

A reading from the book of Genesis 3:8-

I will put enmity you, between your offspring and her offspring.

After the woman and the man had eaten from the tree, they heard the sound of the Lord God walking in the garden at the time of the evening breeze, and the man and his wife hid themselves from the presence of the Lord God among the trees of the garden. SECOND READING

A reading from the second letter of St Paul to the Corinthians 4:13 - 5,1

Just as we have the same spirit of faith that is in accordance with scripture- "I believe, and so I spoke"- we also believe, and so we speak, because we know that the one who raised the Lord Jesus will raise us also with Jesus, and will bring us with you into his presence. For we know that if the earthly tent we live in is destroyed, we have a building from God, a house not made with hands, eternal in the heavens.

Mark 3:20-35

The end of Satan has come.
